Contractor Rules

Revised December 18, 2024

Work Hours

Contractors may operate between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Monday-Friday

Contractors may operate between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. on Saturday

No construction will be allowed on Sunday or any Holiday

Semi-Trucks

Due to wear and tear on our community roads, the use of semi-trucks for material or equipment hauling must be pre-approved by the Architectural Control Committee.

Sanitation

Contractors are required to have a dumpster and a portable toilet on site at all times.

Contractors must also ensure that the site remains free of loose trash and maintain a clean and orderly job site.

Noise

Contractors may have music on the site, but it must be kept at a level which does not disturb other residents.

Damages

Contractors are required to ensure that vendors and crews do not damage the roads and common areas of the neighborhood.

Covenants and Restrictions

Owners and contractors are required to ensure that all projects follow applicable covenants and restrictions regarding construction.

Burning

Small fires are allowed for the purpose of burning yard trash and small amounts of construction debris. Fires may not start before 7:00 a.m. and must be extinguished by the end of the workday. Someone must be present at all times when fires are burning.

Penalties

Failure to follow the listed rules and restrictions may subject the homeowner to fines. Contractors who disregard the applicable rules may be fined or banned from working in the neighborhood.
